Come Fly With Me! Arctic Circle

Theme Overview

“Come Fly With Me! Arctic Circle” is a thematic unit based on the Arctic region and surroundings, with a key focus on geography. Pupils will learn about the location, weather and climate in the Arctic, as well as the wildlife that lives there. Inuit people, their traditions and customs, will also be studied.

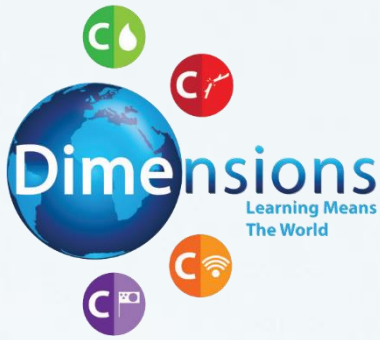
Maths

We will explore a range of topics including place value (within 20), addition and subtraction (within 20), place value (within 50), length and height, mass and volume.

English

Narrative – The Storm Whale

We will be writing in a number of different text types some linking to our new curriculum.



Science

We will focus on seasons including observing seasonal changes and using our senses to explore the seasons. We will also investigate a range of materials, describing and comparing their properties.

Art

As artists we will be looking at 3D Form and Collage with a focus on the Inukshuk people.

Design Technology

We are going to design and make a functioning lever.

Dance

We will watch, imitate and perform some Inuit style drum dancing.



Music

The children will be introduced to Inuit Throat Singing and will build their knowledge and control of their voices over a series of lessons to create a final performance piece.

PSHE

We will focus on friendship including the characteristics of a good friend and participating in discussions around how we can be good friends to our peers. We will also cover healthy eating, food choices and balanced diets.

Computing

We will explore a range of different multimedia.



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
