## Other curriculum areas

Our history lessons will focus on the Great Fire of London. The children will learn what life was like in London in 1666. They will establish the chronology of the fire and develop an understanding about the reasons why is spread so easily and quickly. The children will then consider which of the tools and techniques used to help stop the fire were the most effective. Our topic will close with a close look at how life changed in London after the fire and how it would be dealt with today. We are also excited to welcome in a visitor who will give us a hands-on experience to remember!

In science lessons, the children will be learning all about the life processes of living things and the different habitats around us. We will conclude with an experiment to find what conditions a woodlouse prefers. As part of our learning, we will also explore the work of David Attenborough.

Our art lessons will focus on developing our pencil control as we explore fire themed drawing.

In music lessons we are learning how to recognise the pulse, rhythm and pitch in music. We will then be learning songs and how to added instrumentals to pieces of music.

Our PE lessons with Mr Smith will start with football skills.
