Dear families of our Y3 and Y4 children,

As part of the Dimensions topics ‘Out and About’ (Y3) and ‘Window on the World’ (Y4), both Y3 and Y4 have been taking part in a range of geography lessons based on the UK. As a result, we are going to be taking a walk around the local area on **Friday 22nd of March**. We will be looking at local amenities in the area to help us plot a map of human and physical features and to inform those ‘moving’ to the area why South Anston is such an attractive place to live!
