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Parents Evenings and Wednesday 13th and Thursday 14th March

Dear Parents and Carers,

This year's parents evenings will be face to face meetings with your child's class teacher held on 2 consecutive evenings from 3:30pm until 6:10pm (our last available appointment to book will be at 6pm). Meetings will take place in your child's classroom and learning will be available for you to look at in the school halls- Key Stage 2 (Years 3,4,5,6) in the main school hall and learning from FS1,2,Year 1 and 2 will be displayed in the infant hall with the teachers for Year 1 and Year 2 in their respective classrooms. You will be able to access the KS2 hall from the main school entrance or from the fire door (which will be open) in the infant/ KS1 building. Teachers will then pop to the hall to collect you for your appointments to avoid you having to wait on the corridors.

We have recently undertaken assessments in reading, maths and in GPV (grammar, punctuation and vocabulary) so will be able to talk about your child's progress in these as well as use our teacher assessments to discuss writing and science. There will be time to talk about the wider curriculum as well as your child's behaviour and attitudes within class and in the wider world of school as well as a chance to discuss any issues you may want to raise.

We will be updating the Autumn term targets that we sent home which can be a focus for home learning and will enable you to support your child in the areas agreed as a priority with the classteacher. These will be given to you at parents evening appointment or sent by the end of the week if you cannot attend.

If you feel a 10 minute appointment will not be long enough to discuss your child's progress then please contact school and a separate date and time can be issued for a more in-depth conversation however we would urge parents, if possible, to sign up for parents evenings. Also if you would prefer a virtual meeting rather than a face to face meeting, please contact school via our school email and an alternative arrangement will be made.

On receipt of this email, the appointment booking system will be available from Friday 9th February for you to select the most appropriate time for you to attend our meetings, you will receive a message when the system is open. I hope you will join me in looking forwards to meeting your child's class teacher 'in person', having the opportunity to look at the learning in your child's books and to come into school to see your child's lovely classroom.

I will be available on the evening for anyone wishing to speak to me regarding their child and/ or anything they would like to raise with regard to school. We do have a suggestions box near the main office door and would always gladly receive any feedback.
