

**English****Our class text –**

Our current class novel is the Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. This links to our History topic all about the Stone Age and a lot of our learning is based off this novel.

**Additional texts –**

In our reading lessons, we will be reading a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts.

**Text types we will be writing -**

We have been revising our spelling, punctuation and grammar knowledge from Y2. Towards the end of this half-term, we will be planning and writing a tanka poem!

**Maths concepts covered –**

This half-term we will be following the White Rose Maths scheme and focusing on place value. We will then be moving on to addition and subtraction.

**Times Tables to practise –**

Children in Year 3 should be fluent in their 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s and 8s.

**Other Curricular areas –**

In History this half term, we are learning about the Stone Age. More recently, we have looked closely at the woolly mammoth and how important this animal was to the Stone Age people. As scientists, we are investigating rocks! This half-term so far, we have looked at how a fossil is formed. Ask your child who is Mary Anning and why is she so important in the history of fossils! This half-term, we are linking our Art lessons with the Stone Age. We have been looking carefully at Stone Age cave art and we will be creating our own as part of our final piece.

In Spanish, we are learning how to greet someone in Spanish and we now know how to answer the register in Spanish – how impressive!

In RE, we are focusing on Christianity and looking at the symbols that are important to Christians.

In PSHE, we are looking at the unit 'Being Me' and we have been discussing our achievements and aspirations for the future.
