Residential Information including Kit List (some of which will be worn to school Monday)

As a guide, children will need the following with their name clearly labelled where appropriate:

Warm clothes are needed that can be layered (e.g. t-shirts, hoodies and a waterproof coat/jacket), which you don't mind getting dirty/spoilt. Please note jeans are not suitable for wearing during the activities.

- Waterproof coat
- Fleece / sweatshirts / jumpers / gilets
- 5-7 pairs of tracksuit bottoms, leggings, shorts, ... (no jeans)
- 5 t-shirts, shirts, tops, ...
- 2-3 jumpers, sweatshirts, tops, ...
- 6 pairs of socks
- Underwear
- Swimwear, which can be worn under a wetsuit
- 2 pairs of outdoor trainers, shoes, ...
- 1 pair of shoes (trainers/ sliders/ slippers) for indoor use only
- 1 large towel and 1 smaller face towel
- Toiletries (plus bag)
- Woolly hat or baseball cap - check the forecast!
- Pyjamas, nightwear, ...
- Clock or watch (no smartwatches)
- Sun lotion (in the hope we continue to have some sun!)
- Water bottle (named)
- Small hand sanitiser

Further notes:

- Flip-flops, clogs, open toed shoes/sandals are not permitted outside the accommodation block (these can be worn as indoor shoes though)
- For all activities, all jewellery is removed and long hair must be tied back. Please do not wear jewellery (earrings will need to be removed for activities even if only studs)
- Mobile phone, game consoles and other electrical devices are not to be taken.
- Pupils may be asked to take £10-£15 to spend in the on-site shop. This is for souvenirs and not food or drink.
- Snacks may be taken to eat during the day. These will be accommodated in the leader's lounge overnight.

All Y6s can arrive at school at the normal time of 8.45am and then they'll put their bags in the hall. After we have collected in any medication, pocket money and registered, our morning will be as normal as we leave just after lunchtime.

Lunch choices can be ordered from the kitchen as usual on Monday.

On Friday 20th October, the coach will set off at approximately 1:30pm with an estimated arrival time of 3.30pm. You will receive a text update when the coach has set off as well as any traffic problems that may be encountered to give you an idea of the time to collect children.

Staff members attending will be Mr Brooks, Mr Smith and Mrs Watts (all week), Mrs Rayner and Mrs Beeley (Monday- Wednesday) and Mrs Sanford (Wednesday evening to Friday).

We hope everyone is looking forward to the visit as much as we are - this is usually the highlight of the children's time here at Hillcrest and we hope that they enjoy themselves. We would like all parents to reiterate the behaviour messages given in Mrs Rayner's previous letter and in the event of a breach of our behaviour policy we would ask parents to come and collect their child as they would no longer be allowed to remain with us on the trip.
