Read, read and read some more! We are having a huge push on reading for pleasure as well as accuracy and fluency. We strongly believe that there will be a book/genre for every child. If your child is struggling to find reading material to engage them, let me know and we will help. Joining the local library is a huge benefit for all children as it opens their possibilities when choosing books. I would highly recommend heading down and signing up if you haven't already as they also hold lots of fun activities throughout the year for children to engage with. If you would like to practise spellings with your child, please refer to the Year 3 and 4 and the Year 5 and 6 words in the Learning Log. If they find some of the spellings easy, try asking them to put them into sentences as well. We will be continuing to develop the cursive script with a focus on the size of the letters being appropriate so please use the guide in the learning log to support this.

Please also support your child in using Spelling Shed at home to practise their weekly spellings. We will have a weekly spelling test on a Monday to test the children on these. Times Tables Rock Stars is also very important in ensuring your child is fluent with their times tables. In Year 3, we would expect the children to be fluent in the 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s and 8s by the end of the year. You can find the log ins for both these sites in your child's Learning Log.
