Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may know, in June this year we will be administering the Multiplication tables Check (MTC) to children in Year 4. It is a statutory assessment and the purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently and can reveal which pupils may need additional support.

In 2024, schools must administer the MTC to all eligible year 4 pupils between Monday 3 June and Friday 14 June. However, the following week can be used to administer the check to any pupils who were absent during the first 2 weeks or in case of any delays to the administration of the check due to technical difficulties.

In preparation for this, we will be holding an information session for all Year 4 parents. This will explain how the process is completed and how you can support your children at home in advance. You will also be able to ask any questions they have about the process. We've also attached the parents leaflet giving more information.

The meeting will take place on Wednesday 1st May from 08:45 till 09:15 in the Key Stage 2 Hall, with the PowerPoint distributed afterwards for any parents unable to attend.
