

Things you can do at home to support your child:

As you know, Y6 is the year that the children take their end of KS2 assessments (SATs) in May. To support your child in their preparation for these assessments...

...practise the times tables using TTRockstars or Maths Shed (this develops the rapid recall required to support their calculating skills)...

...practise the spelling rules taught using Spelling Shed. Each week there will be a new set on Spelling Shed, relating to the ones we have learnt in class. Key spellings are also inside your child's learning log. These are the statutory spellings for the National Curriculum...

...read daily, either listening to your child read or discussing what they have read independently.

The children will have the opportunity to choose books from our 'Recommended Reads' to promote reading for pleasure. These books can be enjoyed by the children independently or shared with an adult. They should be bringing one home from day one and changing them regularly.
