Cry Freedom

Theme Overview

"Cry Freedom" is a thematic unit based around slavery. It looks at the history and origins of slavery around the world, before moving on to learning about some key figures involved in the abolition of slavery. Pupils will also learn about modern-day slavery, including child labour.

History Links

Throughout this unit, we will be looking at understanding slavery and its different forms. We will then further explore slavery around the world (Europe, Asia, Africa and America). We will then focus on key historical figures of the abolition of slavery and also looking at slavery in the modern day.

English & Maths




Art
