

Helping your Child at Home

Speech and Language Targets

The children in class 7 will receive weekly Speech and Language homework set by Mrs Barron and Mrs Essex which will be based on their current target. Please support your children with saying their speech target sound clearly at home as this will help to embed this into their everyday conversations. We have also provided bookmarks in the children's reading books with a reminder of their speech target ensuring this can be focused on whilst they are reading. There is space to write any words which the children have said successfully.

Reading

Reading regularly at home makes such a huge difference to your child's learning. Please support your children with their reading book, this will be based on their phonics knowledge. We will also be reading this book with the children daily in class, this will mean that by the end of the week your child should be fluent in reading this text. In your child's reading log are examples of questions which will support their understanding of the text.

Every Friday, class 7 will bring home a recommended read. This will be changed weekly and is a book of the children's choice which can be shared with an adult for enjoyment. The children LOVE choosing a new book each week and we always encourage reading for pleasure. Joining the local library is a huge benefit for all children as it opens their possibilities when choosing books. I would highly recommend heading down and signing up if you haven't already as they also hold lots of fun activities throughout the year for children to engage with.

Learning Log

In your child's learning log are many resources which can support with spellings and maths learning at home. Provided are the Year 1 and 2 common exception words which the children are currently working on, they are learning to read and spell these words. Alongside this is a phonics sound mat which can provide support when the children are writing and spelling words that they are unsure of.
