Home Learning

- The children's speech targets are so important and they will bring home weekly speech therapy homework which will be provided by Mrs Barron and Mrs Essex. It is important that the children are supported with this speech homework weekly.
- Your child should bring their learning logs to school daily, these include resources which can support with your child's learning at home, space to note when your child has read at home and extra learning activities. These will be checked regularly.
- Children will bring home their reading book which is based on their phonic knowledge/reading level but we also promote a love of reading by sending children home with a recommended read, which is a book of their choice from the library. Any reading that you can do at home will support your child's learning immensely.

PE days will depend on your child's age as they will join their year group in the mainstream class which gives them the opportunity to stay in touch with a mainstream setting, your child may access the mainstream classes for other areas of their learning too.
