



Year 5 Expectations

In Class 5, we have collaborated as a team to create our class charter, which comprises of a set of expectations that all children in Class 5 have agreed are important to us.

The children and I have signed this to clearly show that we agree to follow these expectations.

Our class charter is as follows:




- When someone is talking, show respect by looking at them when they are speaking. Listen carefully!
- Use manners (please and thank you) and be polite.
- If you need to speak to an adult, put your hand up. No shouting out please!
- Be kind to everyone and treat others how you would like to be treated.
- Work hard and try your best. Be resilient even when things get hard!
- Following instructions from adults the first time, straight away.

In Class 5, staff regularly praise children for demonstrating our school values (respect, kindness, aspiration, teamwork and resilience).

The children are also encouraged to demonstrate the school rules of being ready, being respectful and being safe. This applies to not only the classroom but also when playing outside or on school visits.



PE Kits

It is expected that the children bring their PE kit to school at the start of the week. They can then take this home on Friday (after our PE lessons) to be washed. 

Water Bottles

The children need to bring their own water bottle into school every day. This is important to ensure they can participate in the learning effectively by being hydrated throughout the day.

Home Learning

Although we don't have additional homework sent home, the home learning in the Learning Log is vital. Logs are checked weekly to ensure children are reading at home and this is where you can request further books/ support. Please make sure children also access Times Table RockStars 3 times a week and Spelling Shed; this will really help their learning.

Reading Books

Please ensure reading books are in school each day.
